

10.7 If a candidate does not give preference for a code for particular course and particular college (Government / Corporation / Private); then it means that he / she is not interested / desiring to take that Under Graduate Health Science seat. Candidate should note that there will be no change / addition / deletion in his / her list of preferences at later date / stage for respective round.

10.8 The candidates may kindly note while filling the preference form, that NEET UG 2022 merit list will be operated from NEET UG 2022 Rank number 1 onwards in each round of selection for each group separately.

10.8.1 Based on preferences given, the seat will be allotted on merit and the allotment will be displayed on website of State CET CELL "[www.mahacet.org](http://www.mahacet.org)".

10.8.2 **Logic of allotment of seat for NEET UG 2022:**

- i. General category seat will be allotted to any candidate as per merit.
- ii. The reserve category candidate will be allotted general category or reserve category seat as per rule of Ear-marking.
- iii. For specified quota (PWD, DEF., HILLY AREA, WOMEN, ORPHAN) the seat in the respective specified quota will filled first. The general seat will be allotted to such candidate after exhausting specified quota seat.

**11. Selection process:** Candidates as per allotment should report along with all original certificates and a set of attested photocopies of each document as per NEET UG 2022 brochure, at allotted college as per the schedule. The Dean/Principal should verify all the original documents before finalizing the admission. Candidate will have to compulsorily join the college and course so allotted, within prescribed period as per schedule by completing the requisite formalities. i.e. submission of all original document and a set of attested photocopies of each documents as per the list given in NEET-UG 2022 Information Brochure and payment of requisite fees in respective institution.

**11.1 Selection Scheme: For Group A (MBBS/BDS Courses)**  
(Refer Table No. 2 – Scheme of admission for State Quota seats NEET-UG 2022)

11.1.1 For selection to MBBS/BDS course, candidates who have cleared NEET-UG 2022 are eligible. All such candidates will have to register during the stipulated period as per the Notice for NEET-UG 2022 admission process for the State Quota seats available with Commissioner State CET Cell. Candidate can register before Round 1 and MOP up Round. Once registered, that registration will be valid

for all subsequent rounds unless the candidate does not join in the Round 2 or is selected in Mop up round.

- 11.1.2 There shall be two or more rounds of selection of candidates depending on the availability of vacant seats during subsequent round(s). The selection will be on the basis of merit and the preferences submitted by the candidate. Candidate will fill fresh choices for Round-1, Round-2 and Mop up Round separately. The choices filled for each round will be valid for that round only. Choices filled for respective round(s) will not be carried forward for any subsequent round(s) except choice(s) filled for Mop up round, which will be carried forward for Online Stray Vacancy round(s) for Govt. / Corporation / Govt-aided institutes and remaining State Quota seats (85%) of Private Unaided/Minority Institutions. While filling the online preference(s), candidates may kindly note that NEET-UG 2022 merit list will be operated from NEET-UG 2022 rank number one onwards in each round of selection. The online data of preferences of all candidates will be centrally processed at a later date for the selection of candidates for MBBS/BDS Courses.
- 11.1.3 The list of candidates selected for MBBS/BDS Courses shall be displayed at the website i.e. **www.mahacet.org** as per schedule. List of selected candidates will also be sent to all concerned colleges. The candidate will have to report at the allotted college with his/her original documents for physical verification and admission. The candidate should report personally (**proxy not allowed**) to the respective allotted college, they should pay requisite fee and submit all original document at respective allotted college.
- 11.1.4 All the candidates to whom a seat has been allotted in the 1<sup>st</sup> round on the basis of Merit-cum-Preference will have to join the college and course so allotted, within prescribed period as per schedule by completing the requisite formalities. (i.e. submission of all original document and a set of attested photocopies of each documents as per the list given in NEET-UG 2022 Information Brochure and payment of requisite fees in respective institution) otherwise his/her selection will stand cancelled for that round.



**11.1.5 Status Retention:** In case if a candidate to whom a seat has been allotted in the first round and who has joined the college accordingly, is satisfied with the allotment, such a candidate must submit a Status-Retention Form (**Annexure-J**) in the given format on or before prescribed date with the Dean/Principal of the College where such a seat has been allotted to such a candidate. The Dean/Principal of every Medical / Dental College in which admissions are so made in terms of these rules, may appoint an appropriate Officer to receive such Status Retention Forms. Upon receipt of such Status Retention Forms, an acknowledgement in writing shall be issued immediately to the concerned candidate(s) by the officer appointed by the Dean/Principal of the concerned college. It is mandatory for every such candidate submitting a Status Retention Form to insist for issuance of acknowledgement thereof and to preserve such acknowledgement till the present admission process is finally concluded. In absence of such an acknowledgement, the claim of submission of Status Retention Form within the prescribed time shall not be entertained. Candidate who has submitted status retention forms will not be eligible for remaining subsequent round(s).

**It is hereby made clear that the period provided for submission of Status Retention Form is crucial and vital. This period shall not be extended for any reason whatsoever. Submission of the Status Retention Form is an irrevocable and irreversible act for the candidate submitting such Status Retention Form. It is made clear that under no circumstances whatsoever, a candidate will be allowed to submit a Status Retention Form after the aforesaid last date. Under any circumstances whatsoever, a candidate who has submitted a Status Retention Form shall not be allowed to withdraw the same. All the candidates therefore, should take the note of this before submission of such a Status Retention Form. Names of all the candidates who have submitted the Status Retention Form as above within the prescribed time and the seats occupied by them will be removed out of consideration for the remaining admission process for academic year 2022-23.**

**Candidate joined during Round-1, and fills Status Retention form will be considered as Status Retention during Round-2.**

All the institutions should inform the joining of the candidates and vacancies arising due to non-joining of the candidates and cancellations/status retention at their institutions after the last date of reporting of respective rounds, immediately to Maharashtra State CET Cell through online College feedback module.

The academic year will start as per the guidelines from NMC/DCI.

#### **11.2 CAP Round-1 Process:**

- 11.2.1 If the candidate joins his/her Round-1 seat and wants to upgrade his/her allotted seat, then he/she shall NOT fill Status Retention Form and will have to fill fresh choice(s) for round-2.
- 11.2.2 If a Candidate joins and is satisfied with the seat allotted in Round-1 and is not willing for up-gradation in Round-2, he/she can fill Status Retention Form. Such a candidate will not be considered for any of the further round(s) during the admission process of NEET-UG 2022. However such a candidate can resign from the allotted seat before the prescribed/stipulated date and such a candidate will be eligible for Round-2.
- 11.2.3 If the candidate is selected in Round-1 of counseling and does not report at the allotted institute, such a candidate will be eligible for Round-2. No new registration is required. Such a candidate may participate again in Round-2 after logging in with their earlier Registration details and filling fresh preference(s). His/her selection of round-1 stands cancelled. The seat so allotted to such a candidate who does not join, will be presumed to be a vacant seat as on the last date of joining and from the next date after the date set out as the last date for joining the college in terms of such allotment. Such a vacant seat will be allotted in Round-2 of the admission process.

#### **11.3 CAP Round-2 Process:**

##### **11.3.1 Available Seats for Round-2:**

- Seats not allotted during Round-1.
- Seats vacant due to non joining / cancellation by candidate(s) allotted in Round-1.



- Seats available due to up-gradation of candidate(s), who have been allotted during Round-1 and joined the seat.

11.3.2 Following types of Candidates are eligible for seat allotment in Round-2:

- Registered candidates who did not fill choices in Round-1.
- Registered candidates who participated in Round-1 but did not get any seat allotted in round 1.
- Registered candidates, whose seat allotted in Round 1 got cancelled during the document verification due to his/her invalid/wrong claim on reporting for admission to the selected Institute, but candidate is otherwise eligible for selection with change in the invalid/wrong claim. For such a candidate, selection during first round will not be valid and he/she will be eligible only on available seats during second round with corrected claim.
- Candidates who have reported/joined at allotted institute during the joining period of round-1 of allotment and did not filled Status Retention Form.
- Candidate who does not join the allotted seat during Round-1.
- Candidate who has joined and resigned upto the last date of joining Round-1.

11.3.3 Candidate will have to fill fresh choices for Round-2. **Round-1 choices will be considered as null & void.** If a candidate is not interested to participate in Round-2, he/she should not fill preferences for Round-2 and such a candidate who has joined during Round-1, will retain his/her Round-1 seat.

11.3.4 **The allotment of seat for Round-2 will be as per the merit and preference(s) filled by the candidates for Round-2.**

- If a candidate joined during Round-1, is upgraded in Round-2 (as per his/ her preference(s) submitted during Round-2), his/her allotted seat of Round-1 will be available in Round-2 and allotted as per merit in the same round. It is mandatory for the candidate to join the seat allotted in Round-2.

- If a candidate joined during Round-1 and does not join in Round-2 (no seat is allotted during Round-2), the candidate will not be allotted seat of Round-1.
- Candidate with no seat in hand at the end of Round-2, will be eligible for Mop up Round(s).
- Candidate allotted a seat during Round-2, if does not join the allotted seat, such a candidate will be eligible for Mop up Round(s) only after fresh registration as per rule no. 7.1.

11.3.5 Following types of Candidates are not eligible for seat allotment in Round-2:

- Candidates who have joined Round-1 allotted seat and filled Status Retention Form.
- Candidates who have not filled fresh preferences.
- Candidate whose name appears in the list provided by MCC as joined candidates at the end of All India Round -2.

11.3.6 If a candidate is selected during Round-2, he/she will have to join the college / seat allotted during second round. After joining the allotted institute in Round-2 the candidate will not be eligible to participate in any further rounds of State Counseling Process. Names of such candidates will be informed to MCC.

11.3.7 If a candidate does not join the selected seat during round-2, he/she will not be eligible for further round(s) of selection. If such a candidate wishes to apply for Mop up Round, he/she will have to register again by paying online registration fee as per rule no. 7.1.

#### 11.4 CAP Mop-up Round Process:

11.4.1 Available Seats for Mop up Round:

- Seats not allotted during Round-2.
- Seats vacant due to non joining / cancellation by candidate(s) allotted in Round-1 or Round-2.

11.4.2 Following types of Candidates are eligible for seat allotment in Mop up Round:

- Registered candidates who did not fill choices in Round-1 & Round-2.
- Registered candidates who participated in Round-1 & Round-2 but did not get any seat allotted in Round-1 & Round-2.
- Candidates who have registered in Mop up Round.

11.4.3 Candidate will have to fill fresh preferences for Mop up Round. All previous preferences will be considered as null & void. These preferences will be used for all subsequent Online CAP Stray Vacancy Round(s).

11.4.4 Candidates not eligible for Mop up round:

- Candidates who have joined seat in round-1 of State Quota seats and not participated in round-2.
- Candidates who have joined seat in round-2 of State Quota seats.
- Candidates who have joined status at the end of round-2 of All India Quota seats as informed by MCC.
- If a candidate is selected during Mop up Round, he/she will have to join the college / seat allotted during that round. Candidate selected during Mop up Round will not be eligible for subsequent round(s) of State Counseling Process.

#### 11.5 Subsequent Round(s):

After Mop up Round, subsequent Online Stray Vacancy Round(s) will be conducted if seat(s) remain vacant.

**11.5.1 For State quota seats:** For filling vacant seats in Govt. / Corporation / Govt.-aided institutions and vacant State Quota seats (85%) of Private Unaided/Minority institutions, **Online CAP Stray Vacancy round(s)** will be conducted by Competent Authority, State CET Cell.

#### **Online CAP Stray Vacancy Round Process:**

##### **Eligible Candidates:**

- Candidate who has registered & filled online preference form previously in Mop-up round of State Quota Counseling but not been allotted a seat till Mop up round.

##### **Candidates not eligible:**

- Candidates who have joined seat in Round-1 and Round-2 or allotted a seat in Mop-up round of State Quota Seats.
- Candidates who have joined seat in Round-1, Round-2 & Mop-up round of All India Quota seats.



**Note –**

- No new registration will be done for this round.
- No Fresh choices will be allowed for this round and choices exercised for Mop-up round will be considered for allotment of seats for Online Stray Vacancy round.
- Allotment of seat will be done Online by running software.

**11.5.2 For Institutional Quota Seats:** For Unaided Private institutions, 15% Institutional Quota vacant seats will be surrendered to the respective institute(s) for **Institute level Stray Vacancy Round(s)**.

**Institutional Stray Vacancy Round Process:**

- Institutional Stray Round is only for Private Unaided/Minority Medical / Dental colleges for 15% Institutional Quota seats remaining vacant after MOP UP Round.
- Dean or the Principal of the Institutions shall carry out the admission of these vacant seats on the basis of inter-se merit from the list of NEET-UG 2022 eligible candidates as per the directions and schedule issued by the Competent Authority, State CET Cell, during the academic year 2022-23.
- All those candidates joined during Round-1, Round-2 & Mop-up round in Govt. / Corpn. / Govt. aided / Private Unaided / Minority medical colleges and having admitted status as on prescribed date are not eligible to participate in institutional level stray vacancy round.
- The list of eligible candidates for Institutional stray vacancy round (i.e. those who are having not admitted status as on prescribed date) will be published on the website: [www.mahacet.org](http://www.mahacet.org).
- It will be responsibility of the institute to verify and ascertain eligibility of the candidate as per respective Central Council rules before admitting the candidate even if his/her name appears in list of ELIGIBLE candidates.
- For institutional stray vacancy round, eligible and interested candidates should approach to the Dean/Principal of the respective college(s) within prescribed time and submit application for vacant seats in person or any person. Such type of applications should not be submitted in the State CET Cell in person or via email. Such type of applications submitted in State



CET Cell will not be considered valid for any institutional level stray vacancy admission process.

- g. Any vacancy arising due to shifting of candidates from Private Medical College to Government/ Corporation Medical College in Online Stray Vacancy Round(s) can be filled by institution. Such vacancy should be immediately informed to the Competent Authority.
- h. Any Candidate if Shifted from Institutional quota seats to State quota seats of Govt./ Corporation/ Govt. Aided / Unaided Private / Minority Medical College due to betterment or any reason by Order of Competent Authority, such Candidate, if desires should be immediately relieved without any penalty.
- i. The admission process should be completed before Cut-off date declared by Central Council and Competent Authority from time to time.
- j. All the admissions are subject to approval of Admissions Regulating Authority after Cut-off date. The College should upload the information about admitted candidate in College Feedback Module of State CET Cell.
- k. Any issue regarding filling of vacant seats not dealt herein above will be dealt with, when arising fully and finally by the Competent Authority.

**11.6 Selection Scheme: Group B (For BAMS/BUMS/BHMS courses) & Group C (For BPTH/BOTH/ BASLP/BP&O and BSc Nursing course)**

11.6.1 For selection to BAMS/BUMS/BHMS/BPTH/BOTH/BASLP/BP&O & BSc Nursing courses, candidates who have cleared NEET-UG 2022 are eligible. All such candidates will have to register during the stipulated period as per the Notice for NEET-UG 2022 admission process for the State Quota seats available with Commissioner State CET Cell. Candidate can register before Round 1 and MOP up Round. Once registered, that registration will be valid for all subsequent rounds

11.6.2 There shall be two or more rounds of selection of candidates depending on the availability of vacant seats during subsequent round(s). The selection will be on the basis of merit and the preferences submitted by the candidate. Candidate will fill fresh

choices for Round-1, Round-2 and Mop up Round separately. The choices filled for each round will be valid for that round only. Choices filled for respective round(s) will not be carried forward for any subsequent round(s) except choice(s) filled for Mop up round, which will be carried forward for Online Stray Vacancy round(s) for Govt. / Corporation / Govt-aided institutes and vacant State Quota seats of Private Unaided/ Minority Institutions. While filling the online preference(s), candidates may kindly note that NEET-UG 2022 merit list will be operated from NEET-UG 2022 rank number one onwards in each round of selection. The online data of preferences of all candidates will be centrally processed at a later date for the selection of candidates for BAMS / BUMS / BHMS / BPTH / BOTH / BASLP / BP&O and BSc Nursing Courses.

- 11.6.3 The list of candidates selected for BAMS/BUMS/BHMS/BPTH/BOTH/BASLP/BP&O and BSc Nursing Courses shall be displayed at the website i.e. [www.mahacet.org](http://www.mahacet.org) as per schedule. List of selected candidates will also be sent to all concerned colleges. The candidate will have to report at the allotted college with his/her original documents for physical verification and admission. The candidate should report personally (**proxy not allowed**) to the respective allotted college, they should pay requisite fee and submit all original document at respective allotted college.
- 11.6.4 All the candidates to whom a seat has been allotted in the 1<sup>st</sup> round on the basis of Merit-cum-Preference will have to join the college and course so allotted, within prescribed period as per schedule by completing the requisite formalities. (i.e. submission of all original document and a set of attested photocopies of each documents as per the list given in NEET-UG 2022 Information Brochure and payment of requisite fees in respective institution) otherwise his/her selection will stand cancelled for that round.
- 11.6.5 **Status Retention:** In case if a candidate to whom a seat has been allotted in the first round and who has joined the college accordingly, is satisfied with the allotment, such a candidate must submit a Status-Retention Form (**Annexure-J**) in the given format on or before prescribed date with the Dean/Principal of the College where such a seat has been allotted to such a candidate. The Dean/Principal of



every Institute in which admissions are so made in terms of these rules, may appoint an appropriate Officer to receive such Status Retention Forms. Upon receipt of such Status Retention Forms, an acknowledgement in writing shall be issued immediately to the concerned candidate(s) by the officer appointed by the Dean/Principal of the concerned college. It is mandatory for every such candidate submitting a Status Retention Form to insist for issuance of acknowledgement thereof and to preserve such acknowledgement till the present admission process is finally concluded. In absence of such an acknowledgement, the claim of submission of Status Retention Form within the prescribed time shall not be entertained. Candidate who has submitted status retention forms will not be eligible for remaining subsequent round(s).

**It is hereby made clear that the period provided for submission of Status Retention Form is crucial and vital. This period shall not be extended for any reason whatsoever. All the institutions should inform the joining of the candidates and vacancies arising due to non-joining of the candidates and cancellations/status retention at their institutions after the last date of

reporting of respective rounds, immediately to Maharashtra State CET Cell through online College feedback module.

The academic year will start as per the guidelines from concerned Central Council.

#### 11.7 CAP Round-1 Process:

11.7.1 If the candidate joins his/her Round-1 seat and wants to upgrade his/her allotted seat, then he/she shall NOT fill Status Retention Form and will have to fill fresh choice(s) for round-2.

11.7.2 If a Candidate joins and is satisfied with the seat allotted in Round-1 and is not willing for up-gradation in Round-2, he/she can fill Status Retention Form. Such a candidate will not be considered for any of the further round(s) during the admission process of NEET-UG 2022. However such a candidate can resign from the allotted seat before the prescribed/stipulated date. Such a candidate will be eligible for Round-2 & MOP Up round.

11.7.3 If the candidate is selected in Round-1 of counseling and does not report at the allotted institute, this will be considered as 'free exit' (option available only in round-1 & round-2). No new registration is required. However, such a candidate may participate again in Round-2 & MOP-UP round after logging in with their earlier Registration details and filling fresh preference(s). His/her selection of round-1 stands cancelled. The seat so allotted to such a candidate who does not join, will be presumed to be a vacant seat as on the last date of joining and from the next date after the date set out as the last date for joining the college in terms of such allotment. Such a vacant seat will be allotted in Round-2 of the admission process.

#### 11.8 CAP Round-2 Process:

##### 11.8.1 Available Seats for Round-2:

- Seats not allotted during Round-1.
- Seats vacant due to non joining / cancellation by candidate(s) allotted in Round-1.
- Seats available due to up-gradation of candidate(s), who have been allotted during Round-1 and joined the seat.



11.8.2 Following types of Candidates are eligible for seat allotment in Round-2:

- Registered candidates who did not fill choices in Round-1.
- Registered candidates who participated in Round-1 but did not get any seat allotted in the 1st round.
- Registered candidates, whose seat allotted in 1st round got cancelled during the document verification due to his/her invalid/wrong claim on reporting for admission to the selected Institute, but candidate is otherwise eligible for selection with change in the invalid/wrong claim. For such a candidate, selection during first round will not be valid and he/she will be eligible only on available seats during second round with corrected claim.
- Candidates who have reported/joined at allotted institute during the joining period of round-1 of allotment and did not filled Status Retention Form.
- Candidate who does not join the allotted seat during Round-1.
- Candidate who has joined and resigned upto the last date of joining Round-1.

11.8.3 Candidate will have to fill fresh choices for Round-2. **Round-1 choices will be considered as null & void.** If a candidate is not interested to participate in Round-2, he/she should not fill preferences for Round-2 and such a candidate who has joined during Round-1, will retain his/her Round-1 seat.

11.8.4 **The allotment of seat for Round-2 will be as per the merit and preference(s) filled by the candidates for Round-2.**

- **If a candidate joined during Round-1, is upgraded in Round-2 (as per his/ her preference(s) submitted during Round-2), his/her allotted seat of Round-1 will be available in Round-2 and allotted as per merit in the same round.**
- **If a candidate joined during Round-1 and does not get upgraded in Round-2 (no seat is allotted during Round-2), he/she will retain allotted seat of Round-1.**
- **Candidate with no seat in hand at the end of Round-2, will be eligible for Mop up Round.**

11.8.5 Following types of Candidates are not eligible for seat allotment in Round-2:

- Candidates who have joined Round-1 allotted seat and filled Status Retention Form.
- Candidates who have not filled fresh preferences.
- Candidate whose name appears in the list provided by AACCC as joined candidates at the end of All India Round -2.

11.8.6 If a candidate is selected during Round-2, he/she will have to join the college / seat allotted during second round. After joining the allotted institute in round-2 the candidate will not be eligible to participate in any further round(s) of State Counseling Process.

11.8.7 If a candidate does not join the selected seat during round-2, he/she will be eligible for MOP up round of selection. If such a candidate wishes to apply for Mop up Round, he/she will have to fill the preference for MOP up round.

**11.9 CAP Mop-up Round Process:**

11.9.1 Available Seats for Mop up Round(s):

- Seats not allotted during Round-2.
- Seats vacant due to non joining / cancellation by candidate(s) allotted in Round-2.

11.9.2 Following types of Candidates are eligible for seat allotment in Mop up Round:

- Registered candidates who did not fill choices in Round-1 & Round-2.
- Registered candidates who participated in Round-1 & Round-2 but did not get any seat allotted in Round-1 & Round-2.
- Candidates allotted and joined seat in Round-1/Round-2 & not filled Status Retention.
- Candidates who have registered in Mop up Round.

11.9.3 Candidate will have to fill fresh preferences for Mop up Round. All previous preferences will be considered as null & void. These preferences will be used for all subsequent Online Stray Vacancy Round(s).



**11.9.4 Candidates not eligible for Mop up round:**

- Candidates who have joined seat in round-1 of State Quota seats and not participated in round-2.
- Candidates who have joined seat in round 1/round-2 of State Quota seats and filled status retention form.
- Candidates who have joined status at the end of round-2 of All India Quota seats.
- If a candidate is selected during Mop up Round he/she will have to join the college / seat allotted during that round. Candidate selected during Mop up Round will not be eligible for subsequent round(s) of State Counseling Process.

**11.10 Subsequent Round(s):**

After Mop up Round, subsequent Online Stray Vacancy Round(s) will be conducted if seat(s) remain vacant.

**11.10.1 For State quota seats:** For filling vacant seats in Govt. / Corporation / Govt.-aided institutions and vacant State Quota seats of Private Unaided/Minority institutions, Online CAP Stray Vacancy round(s) will be conducted by Competent Authority, State CET Cell.

Online CAP Stray Vacancy Round Process:

**Eligible Candidates:**

- Candidate who has registered & filled online preference form previously in Mop-up round of State Quota Counseling but not been allotted a seat till Mop up round.

**Candidates not eligible:**

- Candidates who have joined seat in Round-1 and Round-2 or allotted a seat in Mop-up round of State Quota Seats.
- Candidates who have joined seat in Round-1, Round-2 & Mop-up round of All India Quota seats.

**Note –**

- No new registration will be done for this round.
- No Fresh choices will be allowed for this round and choices exercised for Mop-up round will be considered for allotment of seats for Online Stray Vacancy round.

- Allotment of seat will be done Online by running software.

**11.10.2 For Institutional Quota Seats:** For Unaided Private institutions, vacant Institutional Quota seats of BAMS & BUMS courses will be surrendered to the respective institute for Institute level Stray Vacancy Round(s).

**Institutional Stray Vacancy Round Process (for Unaided Private / Minority institutions):**

- Institutional Stray Round is only for Private Unaided/Minority Institutes and for Institutional Quota seats remaining vacant after MOP UP Round.
- Dean or the Principal of the Institutions shall carry out the admission of these vacant seats on the basis of inter-se merit from the list of NEET-UG 2022 eligible candidates as per the directions and schedule issued by the Competent Authority, State CET Cell, during the academic year 2022-23.
- All those candidates joined during Round-1, Round-2 & Mop-up round in Govt. / Corpn. / Govt. aided / Private Unaided / Minority medical colleges and having admitted status as on prescribed date are not eligible to participate in institutional level stray vacancy round.
- The list of eligible candidates for Institutional stray vacancy round (i.e. those who are having not admitted status as on prescribed date) will be published on the website: [www.mahacet.org](http://www.mahacet.org).
- It will be responsibility of the institute to verify and ascertain eligibility of the candidate as per respective Central Council rules before admitting the candidate even if his/her name appears in list of ELIGIBLE candidates.
- For institutional stray vacancy round, eligible and interested candidates should approach to the Dean/Principal of the respective college(s) within prescribed time and submit application for vacant seats in person or any person. Such type of applications should not be submitted in the State CET Cell in



person or via email. Such type of applications submitted in State CET Cell will not be considered valid for any inst' stray vacancy admission process.

- g. Any vacancy arising due to shifting of candidates from Private Institute to Government / Corporation Institute in Online Stray Vacancy Round(s) can be filled by institution. Such vacancy should be immediately informed to the Competent Authority.
- h. Any Candidate if Shifted from Institutional quota seats to Sate quota seats of Govt./ Corporation/ Govt. Aided / Unaided Private / Minority Medical College due to betterment or any reason by Order of Competent Authority, such Candidate, if desires should be immediately relieved without any penalty.
- i. The admission process should be completed before Cut-off date declared by Central Council and Competent Authority from time to time.
- j. All the admissions are subject to approval of Admissions Regulating Authority after Cut-off date. The College should upload the information about admitted candidate in College Feedback Module of State CET Cell.
- k. Any issue regarding filling of vacant seats not dealt herein above will be dealt with, when arising fully and finally by the Competent Authority.
